Drop off/Pick up: Drop off 8:50-9:00 AM and pick up 2:50-3:00 PM will take place at **5120 Ridgebury Blvd. in Lyndhurst.** For your convenience one staff member will be at the door to help your child in/out of the car. **Drop off and pick up takes place by the white, left side doors of the building.** We will be ready for pickup at 2:50. You may park, and your child will be brought to you. Please be cautious when backing out. Pick up after stay and play will begin at 3:55. If you prefer to bring them inside, please keep in mind they may get clingy, and you may need to stick around a bit. Rest assured we will instill in them love, confidence and assurance that you will be coming back, and we will keep them safe and have a lot of fun!

Dress code: Please send in a complete extra change of clothing all labeled that will be kept in your child's designated bin at camp. Daily clothes should be comfortable, washable, and appropriate for camp activities, (sitting on rug, art activities, etc.) Clothes should allow for self-dressing in the bathroom. Please do not send your child in clothes that you don't want to get dirty, or things that you don't want to get lost. **Please label all clothing with your child's name.** Clothing includes undergarments, swimwear, towels, swim slippers, caps, backpacks, sweatshirts, and jackets. Clothing that is labeled will be returned if lost.

Lunch & Snack: We provide morning and afternoon snacks for all children, please do not send from home. Lunch will be provided for those who signed up. Please send a non-meat lunch if you are sending lunch from home, and keep in mind we are a Kosher & Nut free facility! **Please send in a water bottle daily with your child's name on it.**

Home toys: To prevent disappointments etc. we ask that you please leave toys at home.

Mitzvah notes: To encourage positive attention, we recommend sending in a “mitzvah note” with your child daily. When your child does something worthy of praise at home, feel free to share the good news with us and all his/her friends written on a note which we call mitzvah notes.

Quiet Time: We will be having quiet time from 2:30-2:45 every day. We do not provide full nap time at camp. We do provide a half-day option for younger children.
